The Courtyard has private, exclusive access to the Club for its guests. The Hotel also provides transportation to and from the Club, which is only 2 minutes away. Guests of the Courtyard have access to the bar and dining room for lunch and dinner Monday thru Saturday. Guests should see the Front Desk for details.

Ideally situated in the heart of Columbia, The Capital City Club was established in 1988. Club Quarters and Interior Design

The Club's accommodations include a library lounge, main dining room, grille room, and eight private dining rooms plus a ballroom for private functions of up to 600 guests. Members and Guests need not have a coat to dine in the Main Dining Room Monday through Friday for lunch. In addition to seating the Main Dining Room, we will also be seating Geiger's for lunch instead of the Grille Room (rationale is that it allows for better consolidation of staff during the slower summer months). Geiger's is our terrific newly renovated lounge and offers great views as well as comfortable seating with dining size tables. Also new, Members and guests may enjoy the full lunch menu and the Club Table selections while dining in Geiger's.
